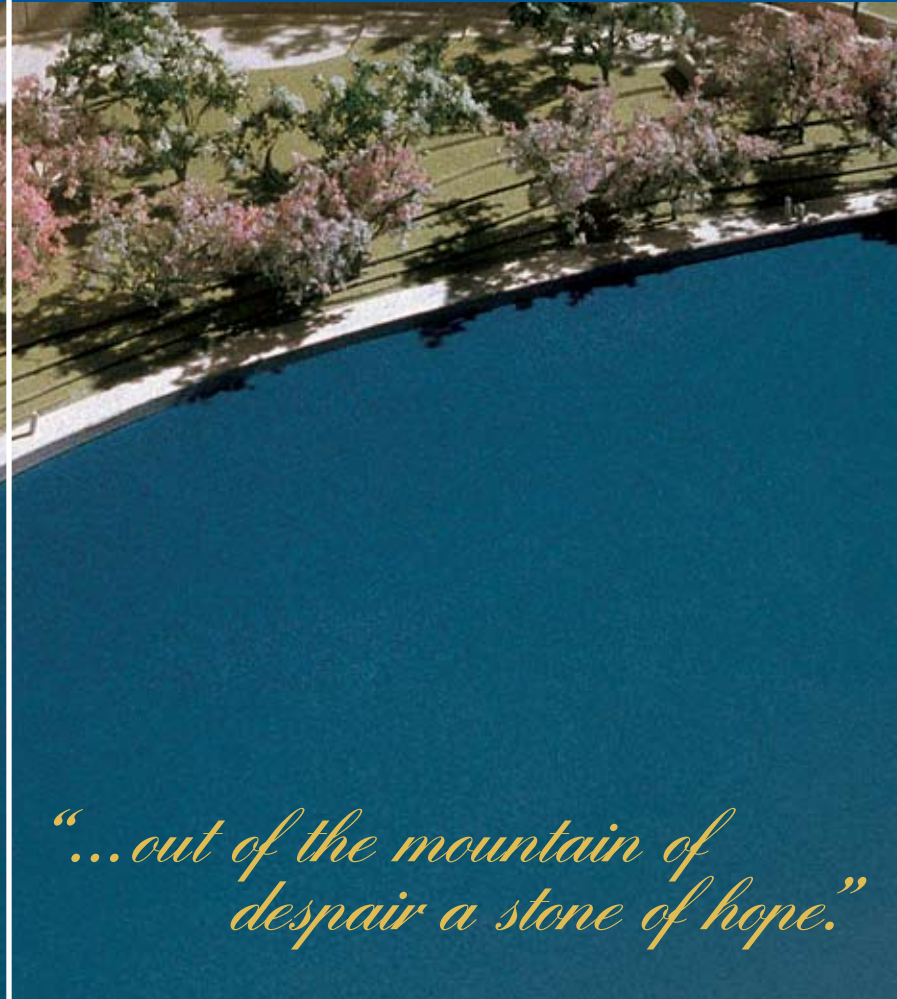


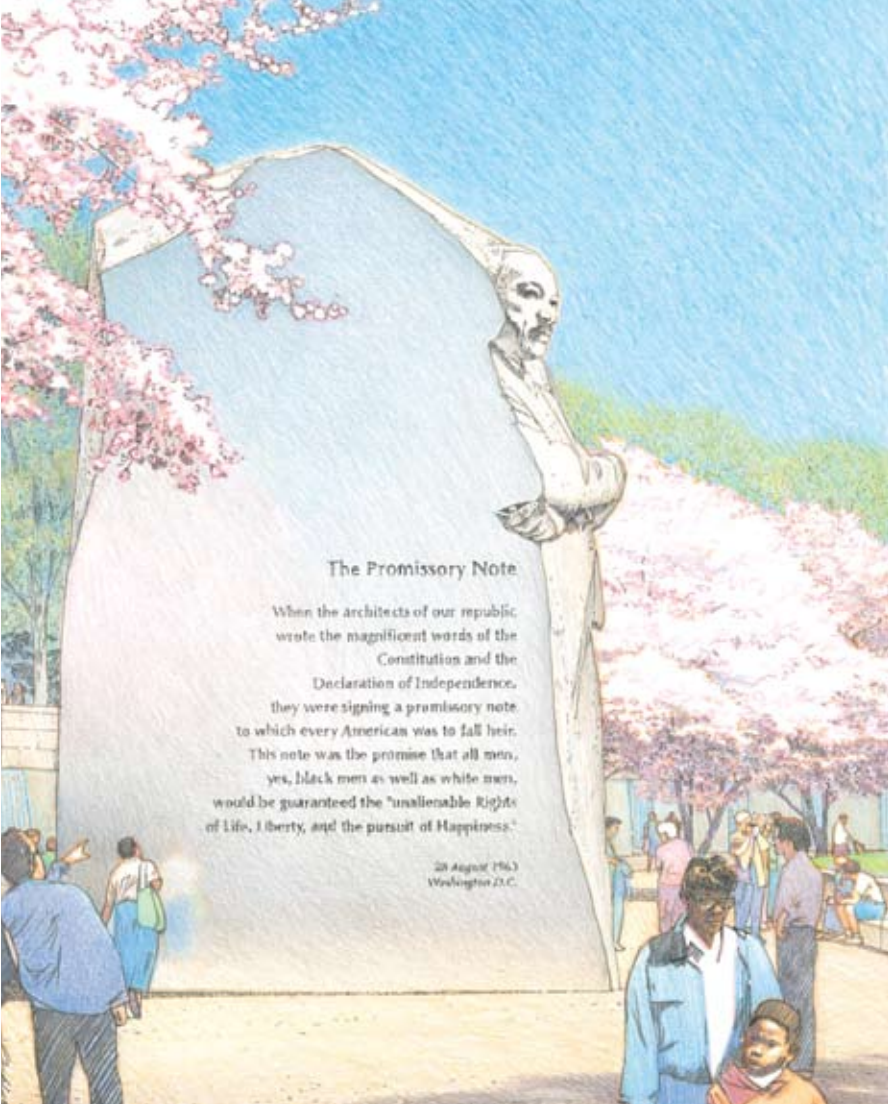

### The Promissory Note

When the architects of our republic wrote the magnificent words of the Constitution and the Declaration of Independence, they were signing a promissory note to which every American was to fall heir. This note was the promise that all men, yes, black men as well as white men, would be guaranteed the "unalienable Rights of Life, Liberty, and the pursuit of Happiness."

One of the most prestigious sites remaining on the National Mall has been selected and approved for the Washington, DC Martin Luther King, Jr. National Memorial. The Memorial will capture the essence of Dr. King's passion and vision for all to enjoy a life of freedom, opportunity, and justice and it will serve as a stage to honor his national and international contributions to humankind. Situated on a four-acre site along the Tidal Basin, the Washington, DC Martin Luther King, Jr. National Memorial will be adjacent to the Franklin D. Roosevelt Memorial and on a direct line between the Lincoln and Jefferson Memorials. Groundbreaking will take place in late 2006 and the project will be completed in 2008.
